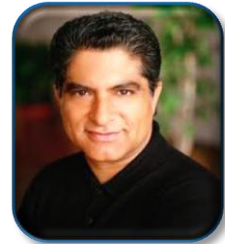

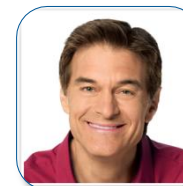

Dr. Oz is vice-chair and professor of surgery at Columbia University, directing the Cardiovascular Institute and Complementary Medicine Program at New York-Presbyterian Hospital. Dr. Oz has authored more than 400 original publications, book chapters, and medical books.

Dr. Oz is revered as a health and complementary medicine expert on both television and radio, and has been honored by Time magazine and Esquire magazine. The World Economic Forum regards Dr. Oz as "a Global Leader of Tomorrow". He was listed in "Doctors of the Year" by Hippocrates magazine and in "Healers of the Millennium" by Healthy Living magazine.
